- SAPANG BUHO WL IS NOW 0.98 m. BELOW 3.70 m. ALERT WL; SLOW RISE IN PROGRESS;
- PENARANDA WL IS NOW 0.00 m. BELOW ALERT WL; IN A STEADY STATE;
- ZARAGOZA WL IS NOW 1.49 m. BELOW THE 3.0 m. ALERT WL; SLOW RISE IN PROGRESS;
- SAN ISIDRO WL IS NOW ** m.; 5.0 m. ALERT WL; **NO DATA**;
- ARAYAT WL IS NOW 3.78 m. BELOW 5.0 m. ALERT WL; SLOW RISE IN PROGRESS;
- CANDABA SWAMP WL IS NOW 3.0 m. BELOW 3.50 ALERT WL; A VERY SLOW FILLING UP OF SWAMP WATER IN PROGRESS; (FROM CANDABA MDRRMO)
- SULIPAN WL IS NOW 1.91 m. BELOW 2.60 m. ALERT WL; FLUCTUATING DUE TO HIGH TIDE;
- SASMUAN WL IS NOW AT 2.23 m.; FLUCTUATING DUE TO HIGH TIDE;
- FOR THE PAST WEEKS COASTAL AREAS OF THE PAMPANGA DELTA AREAS (PORTIONS OF BULACAN AND PAMPANGA) IS STILL DRENCHED OF FLOOD WATERS DUE TO HIGH TIDES THAT CAUSED COASTAL FLOODING IN SEVERAL AREAS OF THE PAMPANGA DELTA.

BASIN SITUATIONAL 24-HR OUTLOOK ON HYDROMET HAZARDS (AND ITS POSSIBLE IMPACTS):

- **Stormy weather condition** is expected over the **Central Luzon** area and is expected in the Pampanga River Basin due to the approaching **TY UWAN** is likely to prevail;
- **Pluvial** (ponding of rainwater at low-lying areas & areas with poor drainage condition), **Fluvial flooding** in the low riverside areas and **Coastal flooding** (due to relatively higher tide levels) are likely to continue to affect most of the **coastal areas within the Pampanga Delta area (Pampanga & Bulacan)**.

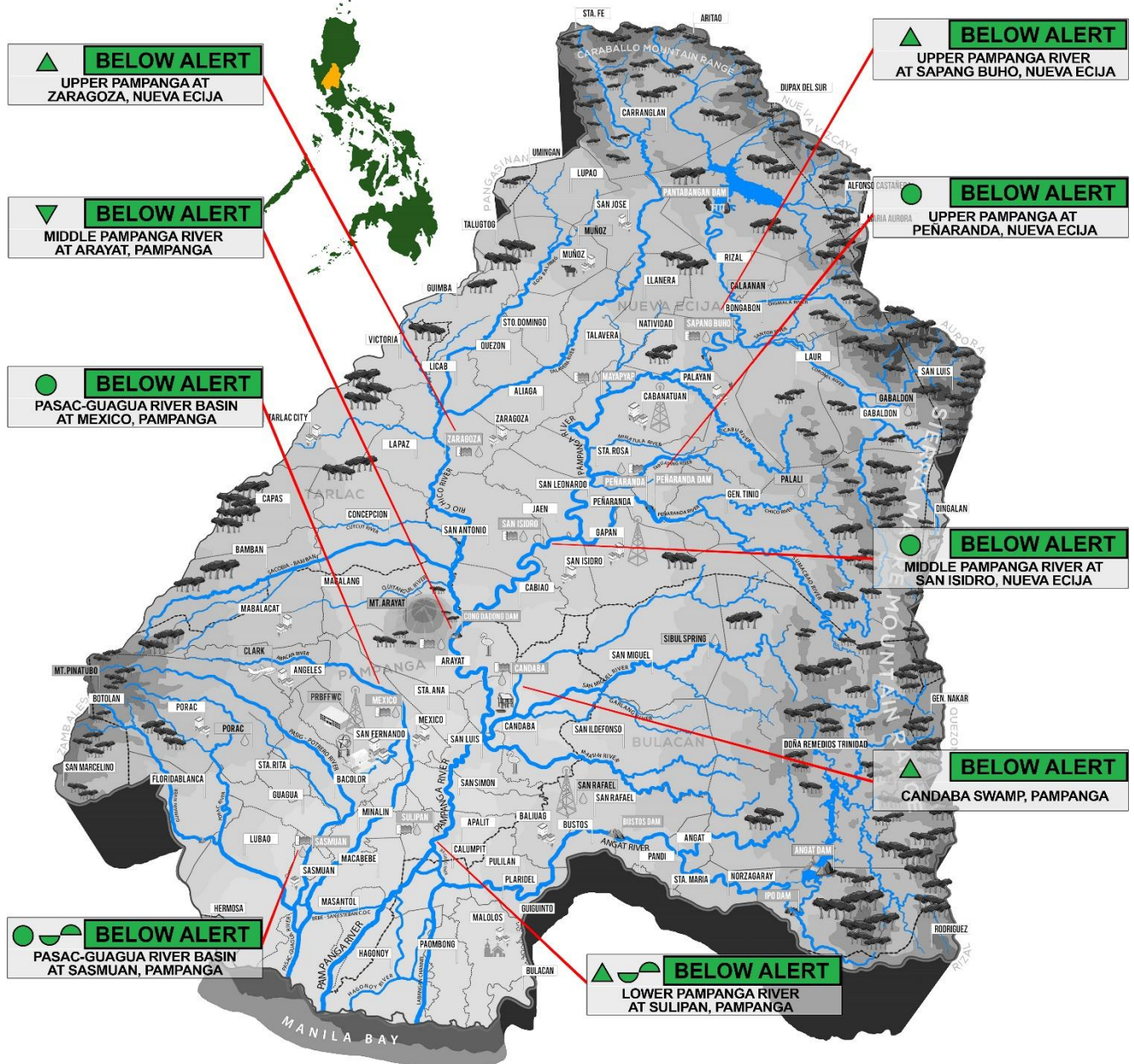
